MLA Photo Contest Rules

- ◆ **Photographer must be a MLA member at the time of entry.**
- ◆ **Categories: (1) Portrait (defined as a photo showing face/head of llama).
(2) General (anything goes).**
- ◆ **All photos must include a llama or some identifiable portion of a llama.**
- ◆ **No names or watermarks accepted on the actual photo.**
- ◆ **No farm names visible in the photo.**
- ◆ **The person taking the photo must be the person entering the photo.**
- ◆ **Photos MUST be 5" x 7" in size, firmly matted with a 8" x 10" matte. Matte color not restricted, but no neon matting accepted.**
- ◆ **Each photo must present itself without title or interpretations.**
- ◆ **Each contestant may submit no more than two (2) photos total - both photos in one category or one photo in each category.**
- ◆ **Qualifying photos only will be judged by a professional photographer not associated with the MLA.**
- ◆ **All proceeds from this contest, after expenses, will go to help publish the Michigan Llama Association newsletter, Llama Living.**

Submit photo entries, prepared as described above (along with a business card) to MLA Photo Contest, c/o Suzanne Hockin Frambes, 14775 Peckham Rd., Albion, MI 49224. Deadline for entries is August 12, 2016.

The Michigan Llama Association will not be responsible for photos that arrived damaged, so be sure to pack your entries in proper packaging for maximum protection.

All photos will be on display at Lamafest Showcase 2016. All entries must be picked up between the end of the final class on Sunday and a half hour past the end of the llama show on Sunday. The display will be dismantled shortly after the last class at the end of the show on Sunday.
